What to include on your author website

■ Possible Elements:

- **Home Page** – Author name/pen name, tagline, a clear statement of your niche or audience, highlight of your latest book, social media links
- **About Page** – Short bio, author headshot, introduce yourself to readers, and provide an brief, but inviting, summary of your background
- **Books Page** – Book covers, book trailers, buy buttons to Amazon, Barnes and Noble, etc., book descriptions or summaries, blurbs from reviewers, excerpts or quotes from books
- **Blog (optional)** – Updates, behind-the-scenes, writing tips, insights, book-related content, or other relevant information to keep readers engaged.
- **Book Awards** – Brag about any awards you receive
- **Your Writing or Bonus Content** – Include short stories, deleted scenes
- **Events** - List upcoming book signings, readings, or other events.
- **Contact Page** – Make it easy for readers to get in touch, whether through a contact form, email, or social media links.
- **Newsletter Sign-Up** – Use Mailchimp, ConvertKit, or Wix Forms, Build your audience by offering a way for visitors to receive updates and offers.

What to include on your author website

■ Other Considerations:

- **Navigation:** Ensure your website is easy to navigate, with a clear menu and logical organization.
- **Design:** Choose a design that is visually appealing, easy to read, and reflects your genre and brand.
- **SEO:** Optimize your website for search engines to improve visibility.
- **Mobile Optimization:** Ensure your website is mobile-friendly for optimal viewing on all devices.
- **Regular Updates:** Keep your website fresh and relevant by adding new content and updating information regularly



Pros & cons of free websites

- **Pros:**

- No upfront cost
- Quick setup with templates
- Good for getting started without tech skills
- Drag-and-drop ease (no coding) (Not all platforms)



Pros & cons of free websites

- **Cons:**
- **Limited customization** and design options
- Free plan includes ads and **branded URLs** (e.g. yourname.wixsite.com)
- Can be **harder to move** later
- **Limited storage** and bandwidth - Free websites often restrict storage space for files and bandwidth for website traffic
- **SEO limitations** and fewer advanced features that are essential for growth, such as email marketing, analytics, or e-commerce functionality. Free websites with subdomains may be less prioritized by search engines, making it harder to rank for relevant keywords.
- Potential issues with **security** - Free websites are often less secure than paid websites, making them more vulnerable to hacking and malware.
- **Lower brand credibility** - Free websites often use subdomains, which can look unprofessional and negatively impact brand credibility
- **Limited customer support** - Free hosting providers may have unreliable servers, leading to site downtime and outages. They might also prioritize customer support to paid websites.

How to build an author website


- **Establish goals for your author website:** Before exploring how to create a website, decide what you want your website to accomplish. Are you looking to sell books, share updates, grow your mailing list or attract speaking engagements? Clear goals will help you shape your site to meet your needs.
- **Choose a website builder:** Opt for a platform that's easy to use and offers creative tools to help you share your story.
- **Pick a template:** Select a website template that matches your writing style and personal brand. Clean and professional layouts work well to highlight your books and create a welcoming space for readers.
- **Register a domain name:** Secure a custom domain name that reflects who you are as an author. A name like yournameauthor.com keeps it professional and easy to remember.
- **Set up your website pages:** Your author website should include a homepage to welcome readers, an About page to share your story, a Books page to showcase your work with descriptions and purchase links, a Blog page for updates or writing insights and a Contact page for easy communication.
- **Showcase your books:** Upload quality images of your book covers and organize them thoughtfully. Provide descriptions, purchase links and excerpts to give visitors a deeper understanding of your work.
- **Make your site mobile-friendly:** Ensure your site works smoothly and looks good on mobile devices. A polished mobile experience creates a strong impression for readers browsing on phones or tablets.
- **Review and publish:** Check every page for typos, broken links or areas that need refining. Once your site is ready, hit publish and share it with your audience.
- **Maintain your author website:** Keep your website up to date by adding new releases, sharing blog posts or announcing events. Regular updates show that you are active and engaged, giving visitors a reason to return. (Source: <https://www.wix.com/blog/best-author-websites>)


Elements = images, text boxes, buttons, galleries, menus, videos, forms, etc.

Edit the header




This header section will appear at the top of every page. I needed to change the image on the left and the menu on the right.

Change menu on the right




The menu items are generated from the pages created. Once a page is created or the name changed, it will appear on the menu.




The style of the menu is controlled by clicking on the menu and choosing the pen (Design).

Don't forget to save




I saved a little too soon and created a URL for my home page that was longer than necessary.

And added images to Media




I clicked on Elements and chose Image and Upload Images


